**T**his is the story of five decades of music both in the studio and on the road by drummer Paul Francis. The book takes you through the highs and lows that Paul has experienced during his long career in the music business.

In 1964 Tony Jackson, vocalist and bass guitarist with The Searchers, rocked the pop world by quitting the band and going solo.

A large section of this book tells the untold story of Tony Jackson and The Vibrations by his drummer Paul Francis. Paul played on all his solo recordings and toured with him from 1964 - 1967 including the reunion gigs in the early 90s. They remained friends until Tony's death in 2003.

Paul went on to work with many artists including Steve Harley, Maggie Bell, Jack Bruce and Bill Wyman. This book documents Paul's career as a musician from 1962.
